Welcome to our first project! Your child will be choosing a topic about Mexico to research this fall. Students will research their topic, write about what they have learned, and present a 5 to 7 minute presentation in class and on project night.

We will be sending home directions for the project in pieces. The first deadline is Thursday, September 11th. Students should turn in their project topic choices. Directions are below:

Topic

Please work with your child to brainstorm ideas for their Mexico special interest project. We will not be accepting animals for this project. Please help your children think outside the box to come up with creative ideas. Their three favorite topics will be turned in. From the three topics selected, one will be assigned. We are suggesting that your child come up with 5 topic ideas, and then, with your help, pick the three that have available resources for research. This way no one will be stuck with a project that has little to no information available. (please take the time to brainstorm choices with your child. We will not be assigning projects until September 11th regardless of when choices are turned in. We encourage you to use the entire week we have provided to assist your child in coming up with project choices that interest them.)

Topics will be assigned on Thursday, September 11th. Please check your child's homework folder on the 11th for topics and the next set of directions!
