Education is a partnership between student, parent, school, and community. The partnership between parent and school at Woods Learning Center is unique and is an essential component of the learning experience at the school. Your compliance with the following items is necessary to ensure that your child receives the quality of education to which he or she is entitled. Compliance is also necessary to ensure that the staff is able to provide that same quality education to each student at Woods Learning Center.

As a parent, I will actively support Woods Learning Center and agree to the following:

- _____ My child will receive adequate sleep and a nutritious breakfast prior to the start of each school day.
- _____ My child will be punctual and attend school on a regular basis. I will comply with the WLC policy on tardies and will comply with Natrona County School District policy on truancy.
- _____ My child will come to school prepared with completed homework, proper supplies, and lunchroom arrangements.
- _____ My child will wear appropriate clothing for all learning activities including recess.
- _____ My child will be given the proper support for school work, including projects, to be completed at home. This will include a quiet space for studying, public library visits when necessary, and help when appropriate.
- _____ I will read the Friday Folder weekly, sign it, and have my child return it on the following Monday.
- _____ I will volunteer a minimum of two or more hours per month or 10 hours per semester at WLC.

Your failure to comply with these items seriously affects your child's individual learning and the overall learning environment at Woods Learning Center. Such failure may result in a decision to not renew your parent contract, and a request that your child be placed in a different educational program.

The staff at Woods Learning Center truly believes that our program is the optimum learning environment for most children. However, we also realize that for some children, other options may be more suitable. As parents and educators, we must strive to ensure the best possible educational environment for each child. It is our hope that you share this goal and will respect the professional recommendations of the staff if the situation warrants investigating other educational avenues for your child.
